LIFE EuroSAP project

- EU-funded
- Coordinated by BirdLife Europe
- 2015 – 2018
- 13 partners, 16 species (8 individual SAPs, 8 within a multi-species wader action plan)
- Life-cycle level SAPs, analysing threats and better defining conservation actions



Turtle Dove SAP – key actions

1. Establish a SAP working group (representatives of range states, key stakeholders and experts)
2. Evaluate the implementation of EU management plan
3. Draft updated species status report
3. Consult on draft species status report
4. Publish final species status report
5. Hold planning workshops (Western Europe, Eastern Europe and Africa)
5. Consult on first draft SAP
6. Consult on second draft SAP
7. Final SAP published
