#### **WORK PLAN 2006**

- 1. The Eighth Conference of the Parties to CMS adopted the CMS Strategic Plan 2006-11 (StP) and for its implementation, «required the secretariat to integrate the objectives, targets, milestones and indicators within the budgetary and other source management mechanisms of the convention » (Res. 8.2).
- 2. Since then, the Secretariat has been working on the establishment of the CMS Work Plan 2006 as shown in the annexed table.
- 3. The activities and programmes identified by the Secretariat, in line with the CMS StP, are listed and estimated and have been given a respective priority index. These include necessary activities and programmes in view of implementing the StP, but the majority require voluntary contributions. The Meeting on priorities to be held back-to-back with the Standing Committee with Governments and Donors representatives, will hopefully provide appropriate resources to implement these activities and programmes.
- 4. The analysis of obtained and expected resources for achieving the CMS Work Plan 2006 shows a total of 84 planned activities and programmes closely linked to the CMS Strategic Plan Objectives (Objective 1: 14 act. & Prog. 16.7%; Objective 2: 32 act. & Prog. 38.1%; Objective 3: 16 act. & Prog. 19.0%; Objective 22: 14 act. & Prog. 26.2%). 46 projects amounting to Euro 5,6 million require finance resources are, among which: Euro 435,000 (7.8%) from the CMS budget 2006 (Euro 320,000) & previous years (Euro 115,000) and Euro 5,16 million from voluntary contributions that are hopefully expected to be obtained/earmarked mostly during the review of CMS Project Priorities on 27 September. All CMS Professionals are involved in the execution of the CMS Work Plan by Officer and Unit according to the CMS Organization Chart.
- 5. Priorities for 2006-8 and beyond will be examined through a separate document to be presented by the Secretariat.

### <u> Action requested : </u>

The Secretariat requires the Standing Committee members support by encouraging their Governments and other Donors to provide appropriate resources through regional initiatives for implementing the CMS Work Plan 2006.
