## GUIDANCE FOR THE REPORT AT MOS5 FOR THE GREAT BUSTARD ACCORDING TO AGENDA ITEM 4.2 (REPORT OF SIGNATORIES)

The Signatories are asked to give a **short presentation** about the Great Bustard in their respective countries. The presentation should be about **5 to 10 minutes** long. Although not required, PowerPoint will be available to the presenters. The report should include the following:

- Population status and trend:
  - Including monitoring actions and breeding attempts (if applicable). Also wintering and passage birds
- Population Potential:
  - Including available habitat, its protection status and possible carrying capacity
- Country-specific threats:
  - Emphasizing the most important threats out of: habitat loss, habitat fragmentation, loss of eggs and chicks, predation, collision with power lines, human disturbance, pesticides, illegal hunting and other
- Country-specific actions:
  - Including past, on-going and future projects and scientific studies
- Cross-border cooperation:
  - Including possible communication between neighbouring countries about sightings, migration etc., how could communication be improved

Range states are encouraged to prepare equivalent presentations, if possible.
