An intervention on the relevant outcomes from the Scientific Symposium may be invited. After this comments from the individual Signatories and the signing organisations will be invited. Conclusions will be drawn. The meeting may then wish to briefly consider the conservation status of the Aquatic Warbler outside of the agreement area and invite interventions from observer non-Signatories and signing organisations. Informal indications as to the need to amend Part II of the Action Plan will be invited.
