- 2nd Draft subject to 2 months' Public Consultation Exercise (April 2014)
- 3rd Draft presented to, and endorsed by, CMS Scientific Council (July 2014)
- Final version published (Aug 2014) as document for CMS COP11
- CMS Resolution 11.18 and SakerGAP adopted unchanged by CMS COP11



Sooty Falcon – International Single Species Action Plan



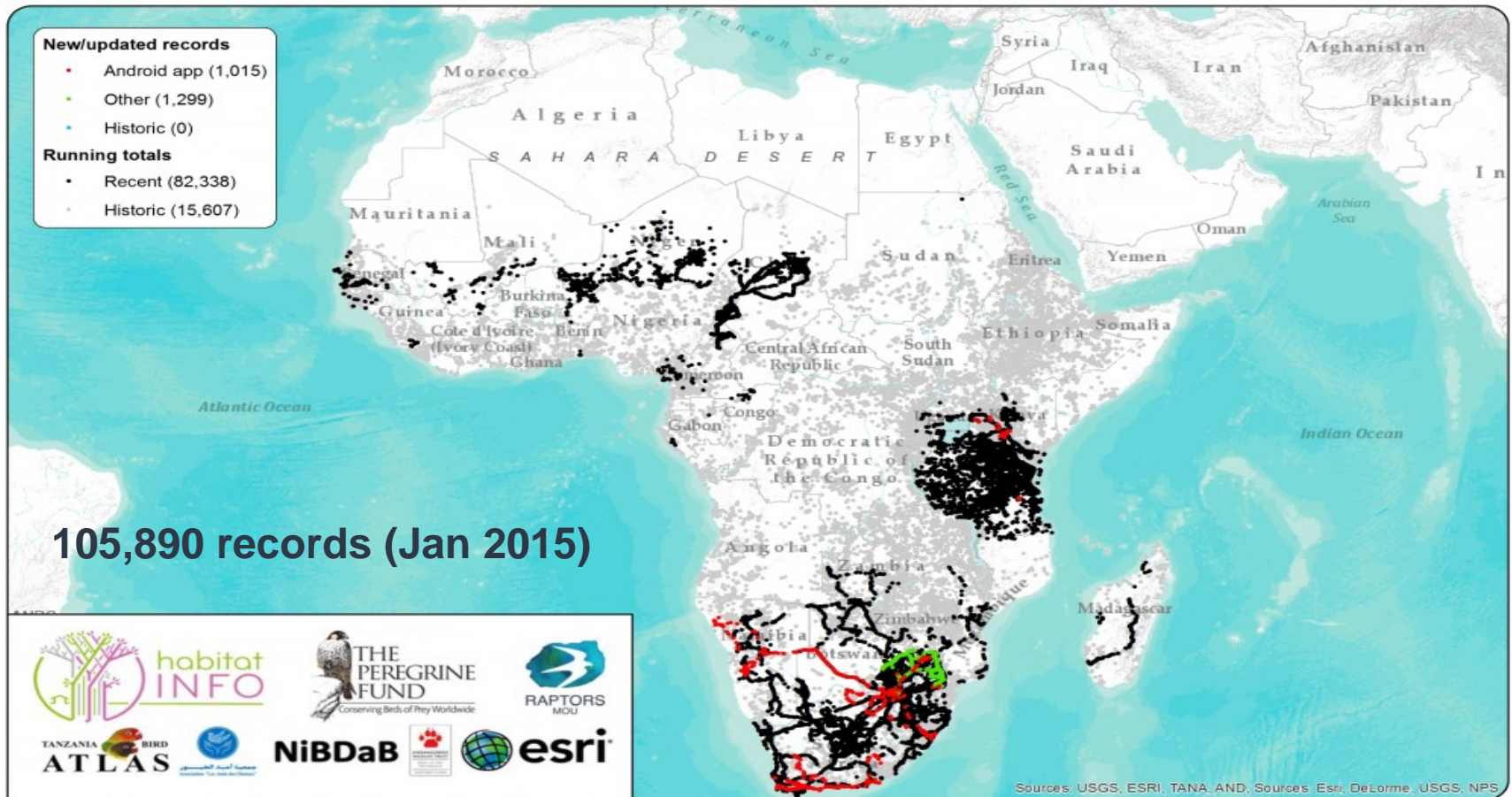

African Raptor DataBank (ARDB) – Mobile ‘Apps’



- Original ARDB platform accepted online inputs only
- Much of Africa not yet covered by digital networks
- Offline mobile ‘Apps’ address gaps in coverage
- High specification Android ‘App’ launched (July 2014)
- Similar iPhone ‘App’ under development (due late 2015)
- User-friendly, free-of-charge ‘Apps’ enable birdwatchers, naturalists and members of the public to capture information offline on their iPhone and Android phones and Tablets anywhere.

Egyptian Vulture Flyway Action Plan



- Year-long Fieldwork Capacity Building Project to support conservation of migratory Egyptian Vultures of the Balkan Region on their wintering grounds in Ethiopia, Sudan and Chad completed (March/April 2014).
- Coordinating Unit working with Bulgarian Society for Protection of Birds (BSPB) - BirdLife Bulgaria to host a specialist Flyway Action Planning Workshop to be held in Sofia in early July 2015.
