WORKSHOP OF EAST INDIAN OCEAN AND THE PACIFIC OCEAN REGION: OVERVIEW OF THE MOU AND CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT PLAN: SCIENCE TO INFORM CONSERVATION & MANAGEMENT AND IMPLEMENTING CONSERVATION ACTIONS

Approach:

Two workshops are held concurrently on 28-30 October to address themes relating to the conservation and management of dugongs at a sub-regional level. At a final session on 30 October 2007 the outcomes of the two sub-regional workshops are combined to explore issues at a regional level. These results are reported at the plenary session in the morning of 31 October 2007.

Objectives:

The overall aim of the two workshops is to provide technical information relevant to the implementation of the Conservation and Management Plan (CMP) for Dugongs and their Habitats. The specific objectives for the workshop are to:

- 1. Further increase our understanding of the challenges for dugong conservation and management throughout range states in the Eastern Indian Ocean and Pacific regions.
- 2. Obtain updates on key in-country research and management activities from range states.
- 3. Further develop and prioritise the Conservation and Management Plan.
- 4. Use the above information to encourage endorsement by range states of the MoU.

In-Country Reports:

Delegates participating in the workshop are asked to provide a 5-10 minute report on key dugong conservation and management activities in their country. The time limit for presentations will be dependent on the number of countries attending.



Suggested themes for the workshop:

Participants of the workshop will explore nine themes which are based on the objectives of the CMP. These themes can be split into two categories: Science to inform Conservation and Management, and Implementing Conservation Actions.
