OVERVIEW OF SMALL SCALE PROJECTS FUNDED BY CMS

The following table summarises information on the projects which received a financial contribution from the Small Grants Programme of CMS, including two projects for which the funding was received from voluntary contributions of the United Kingdom and New Zealand. Overall, there are 60 projects listed in this table, 32 of which were designed for birds, 4 for terrestrial mammals, 12 for marine mammals, one project for sharks, 9 projects for marine turtles and a further two projects that covered more than one group of animals. The financial contribution of CMS is presented in US dollars, unless otherwise indicated.
