Page 3, Figure 1

- P. p. nimr (yellow) should be replace by P.p. saxicolor.
  - Page 4 (Life cycles) and Page 17 (Threats connected especially with migrations)
- Dispersal is crucial for the viability of a leopard population. Just like for other large carnivores, leopard requires huge areas to maintain population viability.

Pages 11 and 15

- The proponent is asked to consider using terminology such as "unsustainable hunting" instead of "over-hunting" and "heavy hunting pressure".
