• Develop and agree the proposed activities for World Sea Turtle Day on 16 June 2021

PLANS FOR WORLD SEA TURTLE DAY

2021 is the year in which the MOU will celebrate its twentieth anniversary – a reason to celebrate, reflect and make a special effort to support marine turtle conservation in the IOSEA region. It provides an opportunity to put a spotlight on the MOU both internally and externally.

The celebration of World Sea Turtle Day on 16 June 2021 is part of the series of events that are meant to revive the idea behind the MOU, namely that it is for helping the people who work with turtles through sharing knowledge and experiences – good and bad. The celebration of the 20th anniversary is an excellent opportunity to bring people together, even if due to COVID we can only do so virtually. In line with Work Programme Activity #50¹, World Sea Turtle Day is an excellent opportunity to engage with the public.

Approach and concept

Oriented towards the public, the celebration of World Sea Turtle Day "@IOSEA" will line up multiple events in all countries where a local partner is taking the lead. It provides a platform for sharing (and dare we say bonding?) for 'Sea Turtle People' to celebrate their commitment to conservation and sustainability of marine turtles. The activities could include those with awards and prizes such as competitions. The event's program in general will last for 24 hours, in relay mode (see Proposed Event #1). There will be two types of events:

- Main events: The events under this category are (co-)hosted by the Secretariat, and will be run at the most suitable time for all. Some can be hosted elsewhere, i.e. be locally hosted, and some could be "Local to Global" events (competitions).
- Local events: The events under this category are hosted by local partners and will be run for an hour by the local partner, but broadcasted under the WSTD@IOSEA banner. They will run in-between the main events.

In the table below, a few event suggestions are made for the main events for the consideration of the Advisory Committee.
