REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK (2019-2021)

(Prepared by the Secretariat)

- 1. This document includes a report on the implementation of the Programme of Work 2019-2021 (POW) (CMS/Sharks/MOS3/Outcome 3.9) as requested in activity 30 of the POW (see Annex). The report is based on an analysis of Signatories' National Reports, activities undertaken by the Advisory Committee (AC) and the Secretariat.
- 2. It was not possible to undertake a review of the Conservation Plan. Since the questions in the National reporting Format are not aligned with the Programme of Work or the Conservation Plan, a review would require a separate evaluation of activities undertaken by the 49 Signatories. This was beyond the current capacity of the Secretariat and the AC.
