




Central Asian Mammals Initiative (CAMI)

- Regional initiative/ Региональная инициатива
- Res. 11.24: adopted by CMS COP 11 in 2014/принята КС11 КМВ в 2014 г.
- Aim: To improve the conservation of migratory large mammals and their habitats in the Central Asian region by strengthening coordination and cross-border cooperation
- Цель: улучшить сохранный статус крупных млекопитающих и их мест обитания в регионе посредством укрепления трансграничного сотрудничества


