



The *Memorandum of Understanding on the Conservation and Management of Marine Turtles and their Habitats of the Indian Ocean and South-East Asia* (known as the IOSEA Marine Turtle MoU) puts in place a framework through which States of the Indian Ocean and South-East Asia region, as well as other concerned States and partners, can work together to conserve and replenish depleted marine turtle populations for which they share responsibility.

Signatories States meet regularly to discuss progress towards implementation of a comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan. The 2008 gathering was held in Bali, Indonesia. Nearly 100 participants from 30 countries attended the meeting, sharing their knowledge and experience and discussing the pressing issues facing marine turtle conservation in the region.
