

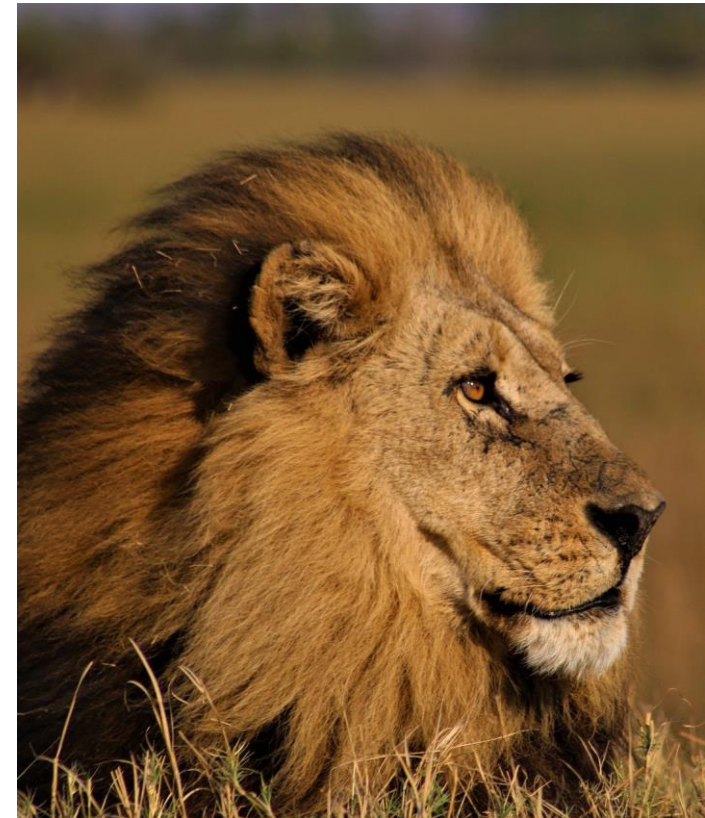
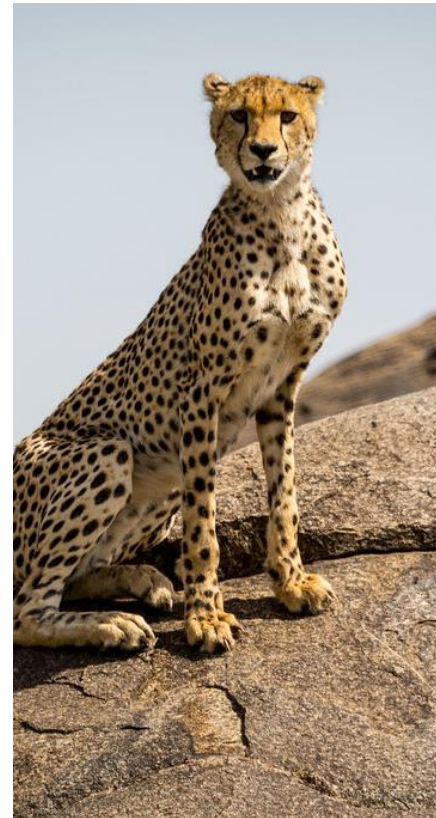


Day 3: Leopard conservation

3 Main activities in your country:

1. Leopard Monitoring

- ✓ Repeated surveys (trend data)
- ✓ 2013 – present
- ✓ 149 surveys across 32 sites
- ✓ ~15 surveys/year

2. Leopard NDFs

- ✓ Ready for review

3. Leopard Conservation Strategy and the Leopard Biodiversity Management Plan

3 Main challenges of these activities

1. Sustainable funding

2. Capacity - monitoring, scientific capacity

3. Illegal skin trade, human-wildlife conflict



3 Success stories

1. working with Traditional Healers and Leaders through an MoU - with clear outlines areas of joint collaboration - use of skins, traditional practices on Biodiversity

2. Stabilizes and increase leopard populations monitoring areas

3. Establishment of the Leopard Forum
