



Information for Your Stay on the Isle of Vilm

We are looking forward to welcoming you at the International Academy for Nature Conservation Isle of Vilm. In order to guarantee a pleasant stay on the Isle of Vilm, please take note of the following information:

- Along with your registration, you automatically receive a reservation for a room in one of our quest houses, including full board.
- The Isle of Vilm is situated within a nature reserve. Therefore, please stick to the designated paths.
- Kindly note that walking on all pathways is at your own risk.
- Because of the many mosquitoes on the Isle of Vilm we recommend you bring some insect repellent.
- Please note that ticks occur on the Isle of Vilm, of which some are infected with the borreliosis pathogen that causes Lyme disease. Please follow the recommendations regarding ticks. Further information (PDF):

- We recommend you to bring sturdy shoes for the round tour on the island.
- Swimming is allowed in the harbour area at times when the ferry does not operate.
- Pets of any kind are not allowed on the Isle of Vilm.
- There are no shops on the Isle of Vilm. However, it is possible to purchase beverages and snacks beyond the full board provided. Cigarettes cannot be purchased on the Isle of Vilm.
- The costs for full board and lodging are to be paid by debit card. Payment with credit card or bank transfer is only possible in exceptional cases. Cash is needed to pay for additionally consumed beverages and snacks, so please bring cash as needed.
- There is no ATM (cash machine) on the Isle of Vilm. The nearest ATM is at Lauterbach harbour.
- The pharmacy closest to the Isle of Vilm is located in Putbus, about 3 kilometers from Lauterbach harbour.
