

LAW NO. 65 of 13 October 1971.

Amendment to Law on Fauna (Hunting) and Forest Conservation (Law No.15 of 25 January 1969).

THE PRESIDENT

OF THE SUPREME REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL

HAVING SEEN the First Charter of the Revolution of 21 October 1969 and Law No.1 of 21 October 1969;

HAVING SEEN Law No. 14 of 3 June 1962 on the Organization of the Government and its subsequent amendments;

CONSIDERING the urgent need for general conservation of wild life of the State;

ON THE PROPOSAL of the Secretary of State for Livestock, Forestry and Range;

HAVING HEARD the opinion of the Council of Secretaries;

TAKING NOTE of the approval of the Supreme Revolutionary Council;

HEREBY PROMULGATES

the following Law:

Article 1

Amendment of Article 16

Article 16 of Law no. 15 of 25 January 1969, Law on Fauna (Hunting) and Forest Conservation is hereby suspended.

Article 2

Coming into force

1. This Law shall be included in the Official Compilation of Laws of the Somali Democratic Republic and shall be published in the *Official Bulletin*.

2. This Law shall come into force immediately.

3. All persons shall be required to observe and cause others to observe it, as a Law of the

Republic.
