The main problem related to the Anatine species from Appendix I is the poaching; - Disturbance by fishing and netting in staging wetlands; - Deterioration of habitats (pollution, draining, filling, burning and removing of water-fringe vegetation) particularly in wetlands along migratory routes;
3a	What actions are being undertaken to overcome these obstacles? - Legal protection of the species ensured, administrative penalties in place. Several administrative penalties are set up under the Biodiversity Act. The Penal Code provides a period of 3 year imprisonment for offences against World Endangered Species. - Legal protection of important migratory stage-posts and sites; - Management plans for some of the above sites in place.
3b	What assistance, if any, does your country require in order to overcome these obstacles? - Capacity building for the implementing agency, providing of equipment and increase numbers of controlling staff; - Training in management planning and implementation of conservation management; - Technical support for habitat management, know-how and training for specialised staff.
