

## **Birding Tour**

**When:** 3 December 2016

**Time:** 7h30 until 10h30

**Where:** You will be picked up from the Southern Sun the Cullinan Hotel where you will then be taken to two destinations:

- Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, providing you with an array of natural Fynbos and Mountain Flora whilst giving you an opportunity to experience Cape Town nature just outside the city.
- Strandfontein waste water treatment plant forms part of the False Bay Ecology Park. An important Bird and Biodiversity area

You will spend an hour at each location where you will have the opportunity to see both Fynbos birds including Orange breasted sunbirds and marsh loving birds such as Flamingos.

### **What to bring whilst on tour:**

A variety of books will be provided on the day. If you are interested in purchasing a personal copy of a specific book, please advise and we will gladly assist with rates and purchasing.

Please bring the following:

- Your trusted set of Binoculars.
- Sun protection in the form of sunscreen and a sunhat
- A pair of comfortable walking shoes or sandals
- A chilly wind can blow, so a windbreaker/fleece is advised.
