A ROADMAP ON THE FUTURE OF THE ADAPTIVE MANAGEMENT FRAMEWORK

(Prepared by the Coordinating Unit of the Raptors MOU)

1. Resolution 11.18 (Rev.COP14) instructs the Saker Task Force to “Further develop, refine, and implement, where legally possible, and following best practice, an adaptive management and monitoring framework to improve the present conservation status of the Saker Falcon through, inter alia, regulated, and sustainable use”.
2. The Task Force has agreed on the development of a set of documents to develop and describe 9 Module. In the previous meeting presentation guided the discussion that instructed the Coordinating Unit, the Chair and the consultant the toward the development of the most important module describing the Governance of the Adaptive Management Framework (AMF).
3. The document in Annex 1 is the first comprehensive draft. The discussion on this document will be guided by a set of questions and comment will be collected at and after the 13th meeting of the Saker Falcon Task Force.
4. Pursuant to the Resolution, a roadmap toward the possible implementation of the AMF in the next few years is also proposed.

The Saker Task Force is requested to:

- a) Answer the questions related to the Governance of the AMF and provide comments to the document.
- b) Discuss and agree on the way forward.
