

Technical Advisory Group

The Technical Advisory Group (TAG) of the CMS Raptors MOU was established at the Second Meeting of Signatories to the Raptors MOU in October 2015. An interim TAG had worked since the First Meeting of Signatories that took place in December 2012.

The purpose of the TAG is to serve and assist the Signatories in the effective implementation of the Raptors MOU, including the Action Plan. The Coordinating Unit of the Raptors MOU will serve to receive and transmit requests from the Signatories for advice from the TAG. Members of the TAG serve in their capacity as specialist individuals rather than as representatives of Governments or organizations with which they also may be affiliated. - At TAG5, CU proposed revision of TOR to improve clarity & readability:
 - Restructuring/reordering of paragraphs for logical flow of information
 - Reformulation of existing section titles & creation of additional ones for organisation
 - Addition of text for clarity
 - Deletion of text to eliminate repeated/obsolete information
 - Other editorial changes for syntax & consistency



Amendments to the TOR of the TAG

 TAG agreed to the amendments, noting that they sharpened the document

- Additional change so that BLI may serve for any number of terms
- Final version adopted, contained in Annex 1
