

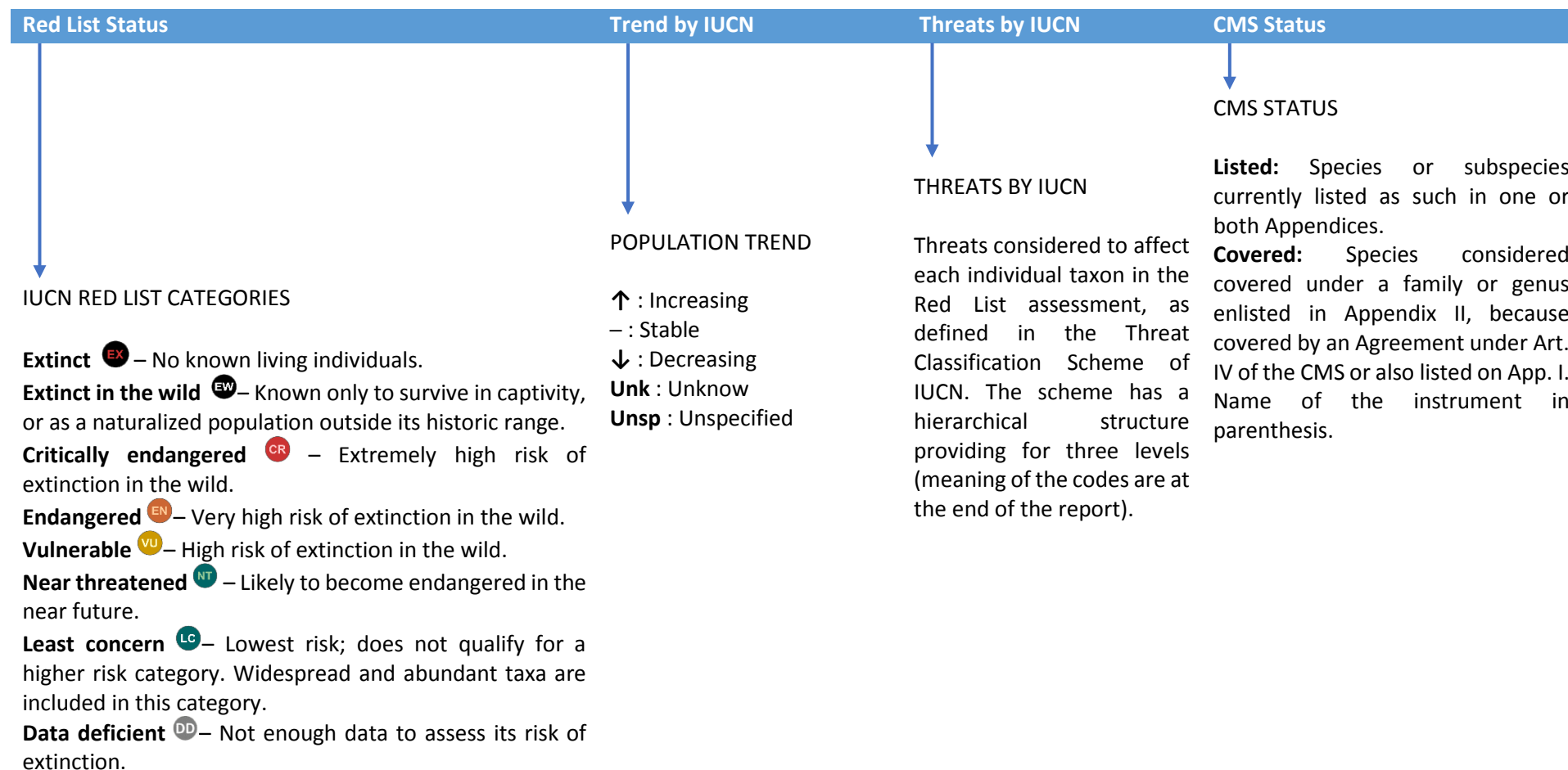

General Information













Information on the status, trend and threats according to the Red List were compiled for the species listed and covered on the Appendices of the Convention. The information originates from the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species platform.

3. This table compiles information concerning the global population of the species or subspecies listed; it does not consider the level of the geographic population as indicated in Appendix I for some species.
4. Taxa for which no IUCN Red List assessment is available are indicated in the table as 'Not Assessed'. It should be noted that, in a certain number of cases, the lack of an assessment for the CMS-listed taxon is due to differences in the taxonomy and nomenclature in use by CMS and IUCN.
