



Middle East Region – Implementation

Jordan signed the Raptors MOU

- Capacity building;
 - Regional cooperation (Jordan & Saudi Arabia):
 - One Egyptian vulture has fitted with transmitter
 - Regional workshop was held in March 2019 by BirdLife International Middle East Regional Office focusing on the infrastructure of the power sector and its relations and impacts on bird.
 - The workshop supported by: the Safe Flyways Energy Project - MAVA-funded M7 Threatened Species – Birds, BirdLife International – GEF – UNDP Migatory Soaring Birds Project, the EU Life Egyptian Vulture Project
- A scientific Report of the effect of diclofenac was prepared in Arabic language to used for countries in the region
- Dialogue started with energy sector;
 - Establishment of an renewable energy committee (Jordan)
 - Wildlife authority establish communication with energy sector (Saudi Arabia)
 - Saudi Arabia proposed to GCC to develop raptor action plan
