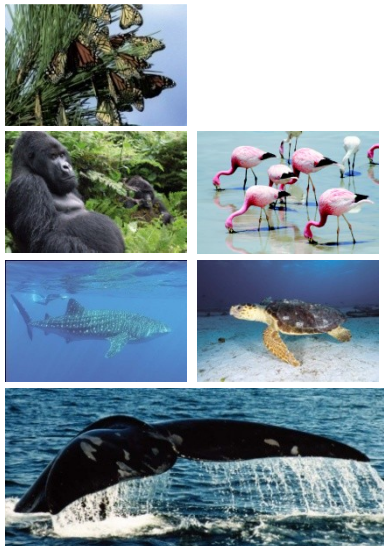

# Update on Resources Mobilization (StC 37 /12)

## Financial contributions

- Total amounts to € 766,870 since the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2009, main Party donors: Finland, France, German, Monaco, Spain, Sweden & Switzerland;
- Private sector and partner organization: e.g. € 10,000 grant from Lufthansa to support the Thesis Award initiative, co-sponsorship of the 2010 & 2011 desk dairy from CBD;

## In-kind contributions

- E.g. Venue and interpretation services from Germany for meetings;
- JPO from Germany.



## Resources Mobilization (Cont. I)

*Total financial contributions from party donors were earmarked as follows:*

- a) 26% to the CMS Future Shape Process;
- b) 59% to implementation of CMS instruments including organization of related meetings;
- c) 7% on Capacity Building in Latin America & outreach activities;
- d) 5% to support conservation and technical work;
- e) 3% to purchase office equipment and furniture;



## Resources Mobilization (II)

**Lack of funds for key undertakings such as:**

- coordination and implementation of MoU administered by the CMS Secretariat;
- reviews on CMS instruments by taxonomic group as requested by Resolution 9.2;
- national implementation including Capacity Building in different regions;
- initiate priority projects such as the Workshop on Climate Change through the Small Grant Programme.



## Resources Mobilization (Cont. III)

- CMS is undertaking the following measures to attain fiscal efficiency and increase available funds:
  - Develop a coherent and harmonized strategy across the Family to create a portfolio based on priorities;
  - Focus on the private sector with a “shopping list” of conservation priorities for which fiscal support is being sought.
