GENERAL COMMENTS ON THE DOCUMENT

- The Sessional Committee welcomed this resolution as addressing a very important matter, as reflected also by the International Biodiversity Day in 2017 focusing on tourism, a fact that might be added to the preamble.
- The involvement of local communities in tourism operations should be addressed.
- CMS, in cooperation with its daughter agreements, should consider compiling a repository of existing national measures, serving to give examples of potential best practice.

COMMENTS ON SPECIFIC SECTIONS/ INCLUDING POSSIBLE PROPOSALS FOR TEXT REVISION

Page 4, operative paragraph 9.

- The Scientific Council may not have the capacity to monitor the uptake of such national guidelines, and the activity may need to be directed elsewhere.
- CMS daughter agreements could have a role within their field of competence.
