NOTIFICATION TO THE PARTIES

Analysis of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework and Related CBD COP15 Decisions of Relevance for CMS

The Secretariat of the Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals (CMS) is pleased to share an analysis of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF) and related decisions that were adopted at the Fifteenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD COP15, Montreal, Canada, 7 - 19 December 2022) to CMS.

The analysis, which can be found [here](#), demonstrates both how the GBF is highly relevant to achievement of the objectives and commitments under the CMS, and also how the work of the CMS can contribute to the achievement of the GBF.
