The Rome Strategic Plan



By 2030, the scale and scope of IKB have been reduced at least by 50% compared with the 2020 baseline.



By the end of May **2020**, decide on an approach for using the Scoreboard [and] set a <u>baseline and</u> <u>a methodology</u> for assessing progress toward achieving the Rome Strategic Plan.

By **2021** [..] carry out an overall survey and review of the motivations behind IKB [...].

By December **2022** [based on need assessment] develop and adopt <u>National Action Plans</u> on IKB and the mechanism for its implementation [...].

By **2023**, develop and/or revise <u>national</u> <u>legislation</u> [based on national assessment].

Develop <u>specialised enforcement units</u> dealing with wildlife crime.

Ensure <u>sufficient staff</u> for investigation, detection, necropsies, forensic, etc.

Adopt <u>national sentencing guidelines</u> for IKB cases.












- Adopted in 2017;
- Addressed to national governments, in collaboration with national stakeholders;
- Based on a format developed by the International Consortium in Combating Wildlife Crime (ICCWC).

OBJECTIVES

- Develop a method to assess progress in combating IKB;
- Harmonise reporting between CMS and Bern Convention to reduce burden;
- Promote the development of a national IKB Action Plans through the cooperation developed among stakeholders for compiling the scoreboard;

























