Day 1: Gruta do Lago Azul + Rio Sucuri

Gruta do lago Azul: The tour begins with a 200-meter interpretive trail to the cave, followed by a 300-step descent with handrails and rest stops. During the walk, the guide explains the cave's geological formations. The highlight is the intensely blue lake, 87 meters deep, which is home to albino shrimp and traces of extinct animals, such as the giant sloth.

Rio Sucuri: Considered one of the clearest rivers in the world, the Sucuri River offers a unique experience: initial training, a hike to the source, and an 1,800-meter float in incredibly transparent waters, teeming with underwater life and support throughout the entire journey.

Day 2: Rio da Prata (Lunch included) + Buraco das Araras

Rio da Prata: The tour reveals enchanting landscapes, from the trail through the forest to floating down the crystal-clear waters of the Olho d'Água River, where it's possible to observe springs, colorful fish, and lush underwater vegetation. The route continues to the confluence with the Prata River, combining preserved nature, tranquility, and breathtaking scenery at every point of the experience.

Buraco das Araras: The tour takes place in a preserved natural area, with a contemplative trail around the largest sinkhole in South America. Along the route, which features strategic viewpoints, visitors can admire the grandeur of the crater and observe scarlet macaws and other birds, as well as feel the unique energy of the place and the echo of nature's sounds on its walls.

Day 3: Boca da Onça (Breakfast and lunch included)



Boca da Onça: The tour is a complete immersion in nature, with a trail through preserved forest that reveals eight stunning waterfalls, including the imposing Boca da Onça, the highest in Mato Grosso do Sul. Along the way, the Buraco do Macaco (Monkey's Hole) surprises with its unique geological formation, which varies according to the time of year. The route also offers incredible views of the Salobra River canyon and the Serra da Bodoquena mountain range, as well as moments of rest amidst nature. To complete the experience, a delicious regional lunch and full facilities invite relaxation.
