Landing in Tangier

The international airport Ibn Battuta is 15 km from Tangier city center. The following airlines land at the International Airport in Tangier

Royal Air Maroc, Air Arabia Maroc, Ryanair, Air France, Vueling, Transavia France, Iberia, Bussels Airline, EasyJet, KLM, Norwegian airlines.

Transport from the airport will take approx. 26 minutes by taxi and 1h 16 min by Airport busses. Buses run hourly in both directions. Payment is done directly to the bus driver on boarding. The bus stop is located directly outside the terminal, in the middle of the taxi row. The bus will drop you off at the city center train station.

Landing in Casablanca Mohammed V International Airport (CMN) and getting the train to Tangier

The ONCF train station is located directly on Level -1 of Terminal 1 at Casablanca Mohammed V Airport (CMN). After clearing baggage claim, simply follow the overhead train signs or take the free shuttle if you arrive at Terminal 2 to the underground concourse.

Shuttle Train: Take the airport shuttle train from the lower level of **Mohammed V International Airport (CMN)** to the **Casa Voyageurs** train station. Trains depart hourly, take about 30–45 minutes, and cost around MAD 50.

Taxi: Taxis from **Mohammed V International Airport (CMN)** to **Casa Voyageurs train station** take 30–50 minutes and cost 250–300 MAD.

From **Casa Voyageurs train station**, transfer to the Al Boraq high-speed train to **Tanger Ville**, which takes about 2 hours and 10 minutes.

Landing in Rabat (Rabat-Salé Airport) and getting the train to Tangier

When landing at **Rabat-Salé Airport (RBA)**, international arrivals typically take about an hour to clear passport control and collect baggage.

Step 1: Airport to Rabat Agdal Station

Bus: Catch the ALSA City Bus airport shuttle directly outside the terminal. It costs MAD 25, runs roughly every 30 to 60 minutes, and takes about 45 to 50 minutes to reach **Rabat Agdal train station**.

Taxi: Alternatively, you can take a grand taxi from the airport stand. The trip to the city takes about 20 minutes and typically costs around MAD 150 to 200.

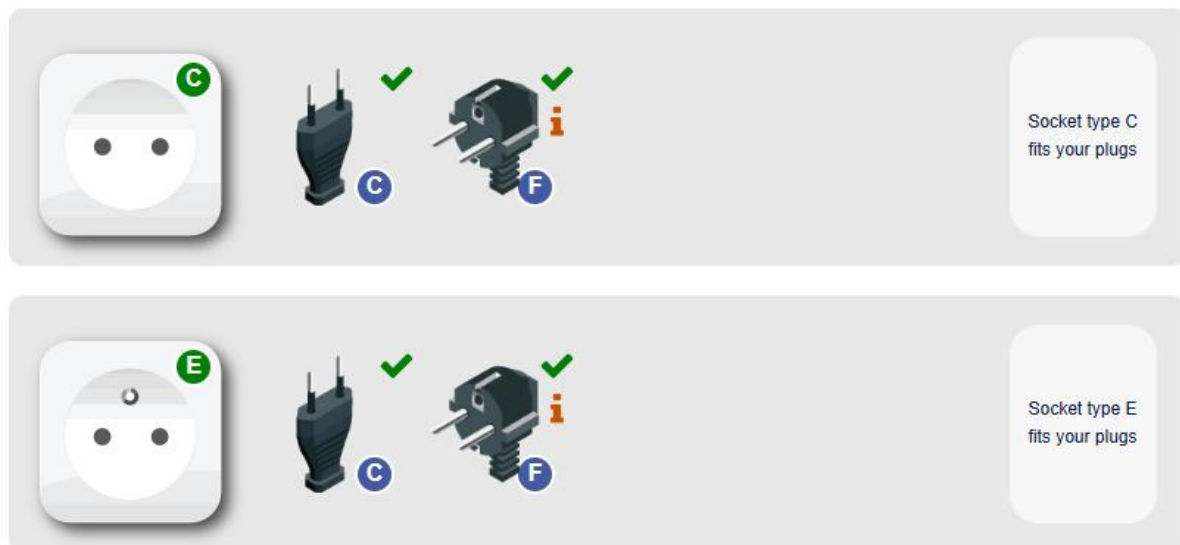
Step 2: Train from Rabat to Tangier

Take the Al Boraq high-speed train from Rabat Agdal to Tanger Ville station. Travel Time: ~1 hour and 37 minutes. Ticket Cost: Varies between MAD 102 and MAD 309 depending on the class of service. You can check schedules and purchase tickets directly on the ONCF official portal

Electricity

In **Tangier**, the electricity supply operates at **220 V** with a frequency of **50 Hz**. You will encounter **Type C** and **Type E** outlets. If you are traveling from mainland Europe (such as Germany), your Type C and Type F plugs will fit.



Weather in Tangier.

In late September, Tangier experiences warm, comfortable weather as the peak summer heat eases. Daytime highs typically range from 25°C to 28°C with evenings cooling down to about 18°C to 20°C. You can expect mostly clear, sunny skies with ocean breezes and minimal rainfall.

Field trip

A field trip will be organized during the afternoon of the final day of the workshop.

Participants are advised to wear comfortable outdoor clothing and suitable walking shoes, and to bring essential personal items such as a hat or cap, sunglasses, sunscreen, and a reusable water bottle. Although temperatures are generally pleasant at this time of year, participants are also encouraged to carry a light jacket or additional layer, as coastal areas around Tangier may experience cooler temperatures and wind, especially later in the day.

Currency

The official currency of Morocco is the Moroccan dirham, which is subdivided into santim coins (santimat plural). Its currency code is MAD and its currency symbol is DH.

It's a good idea to get hold of some dirhams as soon as you can after arrival, as not everywhere will take cards. Please note that taxis and airport buses generally require payment in cash and in the local currency.

You can exchange money at the airport, ATMs, Exchange Offices and Banks but never exchange money with unofficial street traders regardless of the rate they offer, this is illegal.

1 EUR is 10.69 Dirham. Example one bottle of water costs between 3 and 5 MAD. A taxi from the airport to Tangier city center costs 100 MAD during the day and 150 MAD at night.
