The Draft Action Plan vision, goals and actions is a fundamental part of this mandate, that can be later translated into National Action Plans against ITB.

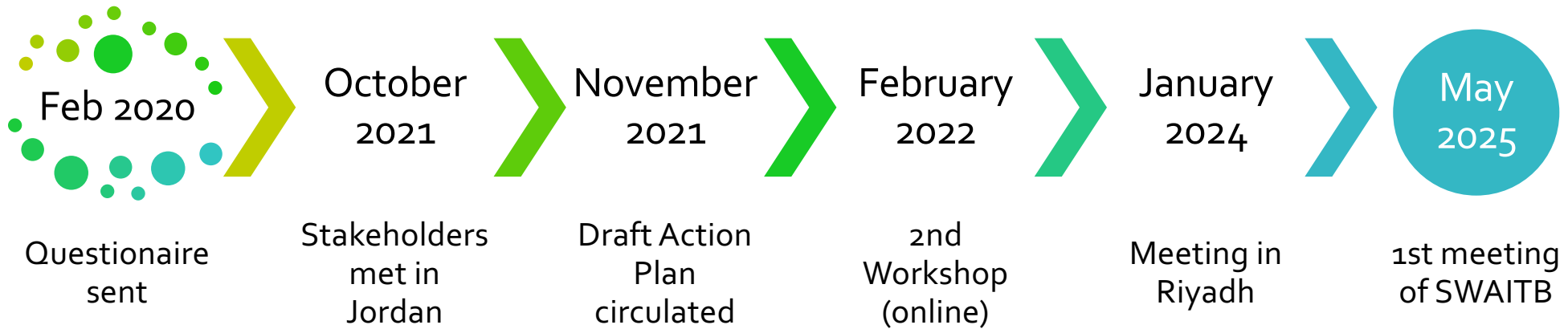


## Decision 14.126

- a) *investigate current levels of illegal taking of migratory birds in this region and to actively contribute to the establishment and operation of the SWAITB;*
- b) *set up the structures required, for example through the elaboration of national action plans against the illegal taking of migratory birds, to ensure active collaboration between stakeholders to address this threat; and*
- c) *support the establishment, operations and coordination of the SWAITB*

# Vision , Goal and High-level objective

## High-level objective:

By 2030 there will be a 50% reduction in the numbers of birds illegally hunted and taken compared to the agreed baseline, in the region.



- **Long-term vision:**
- South-West Asia will be a safe haven for all wild birds and their illegal killing and taking are eradicated.
- **Overarching long-term goal:**
- To eliminate the illegal hunting, taking and trade of migratory (ITB) birds in South-West Asia, through international cooperation and effective national action.
