

### FLIPPER TAG SERIES IN USE IN THE IOSEA REGION

For many years, the IOSEA Secretariat has maintained a database of flipper tag series in use in the IOSEA region, in the interest of preventing duplication of tag numbers, as well as standardising flipper tag codes. With the development in 2014 of the brand new **IOSEA International Flipper Tag Recovery Database**, the old tag series interface was upgraded and all of the data were fully integrated into the new Database.



The Secretariat would like to take this opportunity to encourage Focal Points and other participants to bring with them an **up-to-date list of flipper tags** used in their country and/or to correspond with the Secretariat soon after the SS7 meeting, so that the database reflects more accurately the current situation.

Preferably before leaving for Bonn, please consult the database record for your country (see URL on the next page) and check: (1) whether the information on the Contact Person & Agency is still valid; and (2) whether any new tag series have been ordered, but have not been notified to the Secretariat.

#### Flipper Tag Series

Whereas there is considerable information available on tag numbers used in the Atlantic and Pacific Ocean basins, through the ACCSTR (Archie Carr Center for Sea Turtle Research) Sea Turtle Tag Inventory, the coverage of the IOSEA region has, until now, been relatively poor.

The following tables have been prepared in the interest of preventing duplication of tag numbers, as well as standardising flipper tag codes used throughout the Indian Ocean – South-East Asia

Anyone who is currently tagging turtles in any of the 40+ IOSEA States, as part of a government or private/NGO-run programme, or who has accurate information on tag series that have been used in the past, is encouraged to provide the relevant details for inclusion in the table.

Please send a note to the IOSEA Secretariat containing as much of the information as possible, including any corrections. Partial entries are also welcome, as they may prompt others to provide the mission details
