



4th Meeting of the Range States for the European Eel

Elite Hotel Savoy

Malmö, Sweden, 14-15 October 2025

FACT SHEET FOR PARTICIPANTS

I. Getting to Malmö

Elite Hotel Savoy is located in Malmö in the very south of Sweden across the bridge from Copenhagen, Denmark. The distance between Copenhagen and Malmö is approximately 25 km and it will take you about 20 minutes to travel from Copenhagen to Malmö by train. Do not book your ticket to Stockholm (the capital of Sweden), which is located about 800 km north of Malmö. Book your ticket directly to Malmö or Copenhagen.

Copenhagen International Airport (Kastrup - CPH)

Copenhagen Airport is one of the largest international airports in northern Europe. You can take the train (called 'Öresundståg' in Swedish) from Terminal 3. It will take you across the strait between Denmark and Sweden, via the Öresund bridge, to Malmö Central Station. The journey takes 20 minutes. Train tickets can be purchased in the arrival hall after you have collected your baggage and cleared immigration. You must purchase your ticket before boarding the train. Trains depart several times an hour and a one-way ticket costs 150 Swedish Crowns (SEK). The closest stop to our venue is Malmö Central and it is the third stop in Sweden. Sturup Airport

Sturup airport is located in Sweden about 30 km outside Malmö. You can take a taxi to your destination of choice, or ride the bus to the Central Station in Malmö. The journey is approximately 45 minutes. From the train station, you could take a taxi to your accommodation, although most hotels, and the venue are within reasonable walking distance.

Malmö Public transport system

Central Station is the hub for Malmö's excellent public transportation system. Please note that all tickets for train and bus travel must be purchased before boarding as cash is not accepted on buses or trains. Staff at the Central Station transport office, Skånetafiken, can advise you on the best option for travel and purchasing tickets based on your destination. Information in English about local bus and train travel can be found at the Skånetafiken website.

Taxis

The Central Station is the closest train stop, and main bus stop, to our venue. There is a taxi stand outside Central Station if needed although Elite Hotel Savoy and most other hotels are within reasonable walking distance.

The meeting will take place at Elite Hotel Savoy in Malmö City Centre.

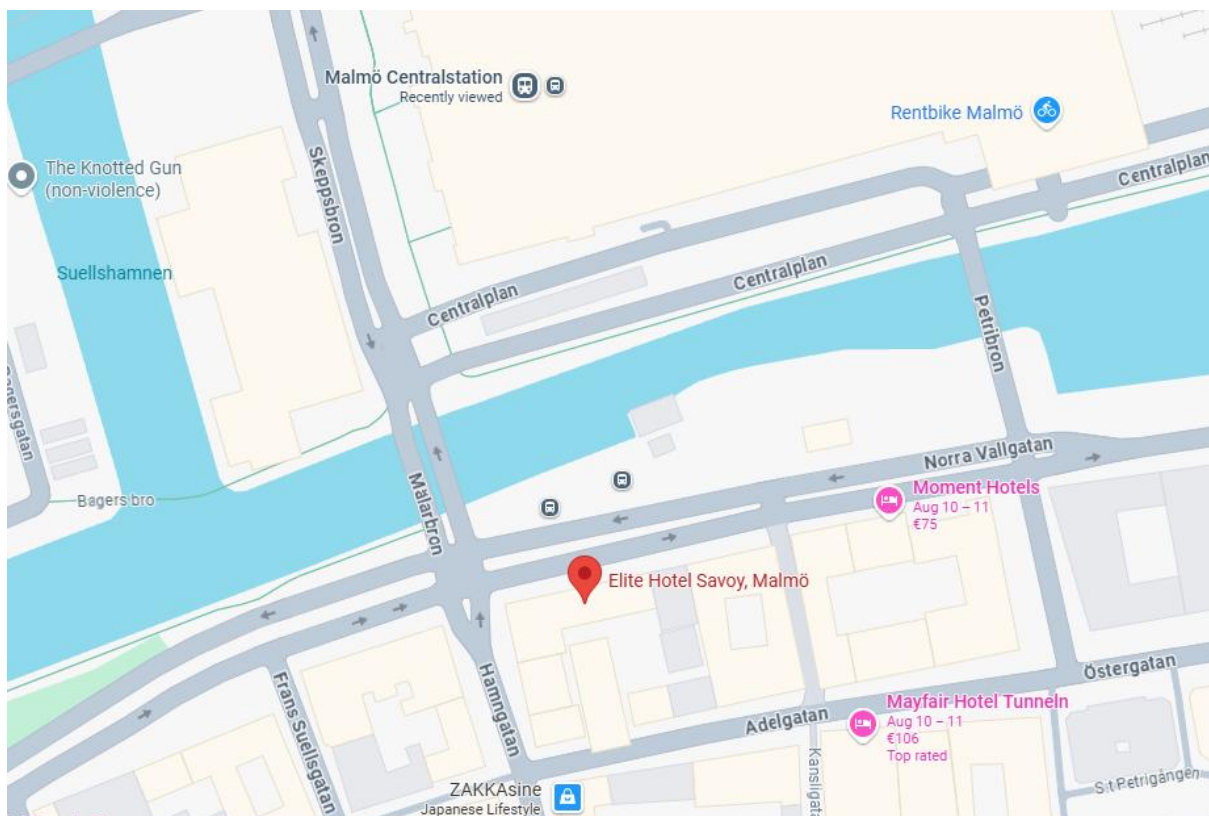

III. Registration

Registration will start at 08.30 on 14.10.2025 at our venue.

IV. Hotel Accommodation

1. Funded participants will receive full DSA and are asked to make their own hotel reservations. Please note that you will have to submit your hotel receipt to the travel organizers after the meeting.

2. Meeting participants will receive a special rate for the **Elite Hotel Savoy (venue)**. Either by using this link: [Convention on Migratory Species](#) or by booking on the hotel website and use the following booking code: **European Eel**. Reservations can be made with the discounted rate until 14.09.2025

There are plenty of other accommodations near the venue and the Secretariat suggests using one of the many existing booking platforms.

V. Weather

The climate in Malmö during October can be summarized as moderately chilly and slightly windy. With an average temperature between 12°C and 9°C degrees Celsius.

Please do not forget to bring your raincoat, umbrella and a warm jacket since weather in Northern Europe is at best unpredictable and it can be cold.

VI. Currency

Sweden's currency is the Swedish Krona (SEK). As of 08 August 2025, the exchange rate was €0.84 or \$1.08 for 10 SEK. Please note that Sweden is a nearly cashless country - bring your debit/credit card. Many Swedes prefer to use plastic over cash - some cafes and kiosks in Stockholm even refuse cash payments and accept cards only. So, you are not likely to need a great deal of hard currency for your travel.

VII. Voltage and Type of Pins

In Sweden, the electrical plug/ outlet and voltage operates on **230 volts, 50 Hz**, with round-prong European-style plugs that fit into recessed wall sockets/ points. Many appliances with their own power adapters (such as laptop computers and digital cameras) can be plugged into either 110-120 volt or 220-240-volt sockets/points and will adapt to the voltage automatically.



VIII. Visas

Upon request, an official letter of invitation will be sent to participants. This can be attached to the Swedish visa application. Visas can be obtained from your nearest Swedish embassy or consulate. Information and addresses can be downloaded from the website of the Swedish Foreign Office. <https://www.swedenabroad.se/en/>
