IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK 2018-2020

(Prepared by the Secretariat)

Summary:

The present document provides the status of implementation of the Programme of Work (POW) for 2018-2020, as at December 2019, following its adoption by the Twelfth Meeting of the Conference of the Parties (October 2017, Manila).

The progress report is presented in tabular form in the Annex to this document.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK 2018-2020

Background

- 1. The Programme of Work (POW) for 2018-2020, as it was adopted by the Twelfth Meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP12, 23-28 October 2017, Manila), contains all mandates falling under the responsibility of the Secretariat as well as those that fall under the Standing Committee, the Scientific Council and their Working Groups and require the Secretariat's support.
- 2. Many of these mandates relate to existing instruments under CMS, being the Gorilla Agreement, all CMS Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) including those serviced by dedicated personnel, such as those on Dugongs, Birds of Prey, Sharks and marine turtles of the Indian Ocean and South-east Asia as well as Action Plans; Programmes of Work; Initiatives; Concerted Actions and provisions of Resolutions and Decisions that were adopted by COP12 as well as those which were retained in full.
- 3. The detailed list of activities is grouped into programme areas as follows:
 - Executive Direction and Management;
 - Implementation Support;
 - Resource Mobilization and Interagency Affairs;
 - Information Management, Communication and Outreach;
 - Capacity-building;
 - Servicing of Governing Bodies

Activities since COP12

- 4. Following the adoption of the POW and in line with Decision 12.105 (a), a correlation was made for each activity to the Targets of the Strategic Plan for Migratory Species and to those of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) with a view to determining and monitoring the contributions of the Secretariat to the Strategic Plan for Migratory Species (SPMS) and the SGDs. On 4 January 2018, the Secretariat notified Parties (<u>Notification 2017/022</u>) of the inclusion of linkages to the SDGs and SPMS Targets and invited them to explore any opportunity to allocate resources to support the implementation of those activities that require financial assistance.
- 5. By October 2018, the financial and in-kind support that had been secured by the Secretariat, although sizeable, represented only approximately 12 per cent of the total required for the triennium to fully implement the POW, i.e. almost €72 millions¹ (excluding staff costs and other costs covered by the CMS core budget).
- 6. A report on progress was prepared for the consideration of the Standing Committee at its 48th Meeting (23-24 October 2018, Bonn, Germany) and consisted of two sections, these being (i) a narrative report on the status of implementation, including the challenges the Secretariat has been facing and planned steps to carry out each activity and (ii) the POW in tabular form with a brief overview through a traffic-light rating system.

- 7. On 29 March 2019 the Secretariat issued <u>Notification 2019/003</u> to call again for financial assistance and to highlight that, with COP13 being held so early in the triennium, the time available for the implementation of the POW was reduced significantly thus requiring reprioritizing and reshuffling actions. A list of priorities for funding for 2019 was included in the Annex to the Notification.
- 8. The current document presents only the POW in tabular form in Annex 1 as comprehensive narratives have been included in the documents prepared under related COP-agenda items. Annex 1 provides a synopsis of the status of implementation of the POW through a traffic-light rating system for 2018 and 2019 activities and to some extent for those activities that were originally planned for 2020 but that had to be carried out earlier in view of COP13.
- 9. For each activity, the funding source is indicated as funds provided through the CMS core budget 2018-2020 and/or through voluntary contributions. Where no funding source is indicated (blanks), the activity could be carried out by staff at the Secretariat without remunerated external input.
- 10. The financial support generated so far for the implementation of the POW amounts to almost €10 million representing 14 per cent of the total required. Despite the significant financial gap, many activities have been completed and/or have been progressed with fewer resources than estimated and with the Secretariat's in-house capacity.
- 11. These gaps in implementation have been reflected in the draft POW for the intersessional period between COP13 and COP14, which is contained in Annex 6 of COP13/Doc.13.2 Budget 2021-2023 and Programme of Work for the intersessional period between COP13 and COP14.

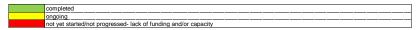
Recommended Actions
