- Members and alternates not eligible for funding are kindly requested to confirm their intention to participate in the meeting by completing the online pre-registration form at their earliest convenience and no later than **7 April 2027**.
- Any body or agency that is not a member of the Committee and wishes to observe the meeting shall submit a request to the Secretariat no later than **14 March 2027**. Completing the CMS registration form shall serve as a request to participate.
