# **COP12 COMMUNICATIONS GUIDE**



The 12<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals (CMS COP12) will be the largest wildlife conference this year, with over 500 delegates from more than 120 countries expected to attend. COP12 will also be the first time that a CMS COP will be held in Asia. The programme will include a High-Level Panel, a Champion Night and over 50 side events as well as celebrity events throughout the week.

The theme of COP12 is "Their Future is Our Future – Sustainable Development for Wildlife and People". It reflects the intrinsic link between the world's wildlife, the environment and the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
