ADMISSION OF OBSERVERS

Summary:

With reference to Article VII paragraph 9 of the Convention, the present document includes a list of agencies and bodies that have notified the Secretariat of their desire to be represented at the 11th Meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP11) by observers through pre-registration.

Admission of these agencies and bodies will be confirmed at the beginning of the Meeting. Should any Party have an objection on the participation of any of the agencies or bodies included in the list, it is request to inform the Secretariat as soon as possible in advance of the Meeting.

This document has been revised to account for agencies and bodies that registered for the meeting after distribution of the original document.



ADMISSION OF OBSERVERS

(Prepared by the UNEP/CMS Secretariat)

- 1. Article VII paragraph 9 of the Convention stipulates that 'Any agency or body technically qualified in protection, conservation and management of migratory species, in the following categories, which has informed the Secretariat of its desire to be represented at meetings of the Conference of the Parties by observers, shall be admitted unless at least one-third of the Parties present object:
- a) international agencies or bodies, either governmental or non-governmental, and national governmental agencies and bodies; and
- b) national non-governmental agencies or bodies which have been approved for this purpose by the State in which they are located.

Once admitted, these observers shall have the right to participate but not to vote.'

2. The present document includes as an Annex a list of agencies and bodies belonging to the above-mentioned categories that have notified the Secretariat of their desire to be represented at the 11th Meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP11) through pre-registration as at 1 October 2014. Admission of these agencies and bodies will be confirmed at the beginning of the Meeting. Should any Party have an objection on the participation of any of the agencies or bodies included in the list, it is request to inform the Secretariat as soon as possible in advance of the meeting.

Action requested:

The Conference of the Parties is expected to confirm the admission of observers, as appropriate.
