3 MAIN ACTIVITIES IN THE COUNTRY:

- 1. Reviewing and updating of National legislation to incorporate emerging issues and meet present day challenges on wildlife conservation and management.
- 2. Wildlife Disease surveillance
- 3. Joint patrolling involving members of the community for poaching of animals

3 MAIN CHALLENGES OF THESE ACTIVITIES

- Support inventory of the ACI species found in Sierra Leone
- Lack of funds for finalizing the reviewing process of the legislation, lack of forestry monitoring tools, lack of mobility for forest patrol
- 3. Low awareness in the remote areas of the country on the role wildlife play in addressing disease outbreak and the hunting of wildlife for bushmeat

3 SUCCESS STORIES

- 1. Creation of a stand-alone Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change
- 2. 2. Establishment of an Environmental court for the speedy prosecution of wildlife crimes
- 3. Inclusion of the Wildlife Management Unit of the Forestry Department into the National Disease Surveillance Taskforce.
